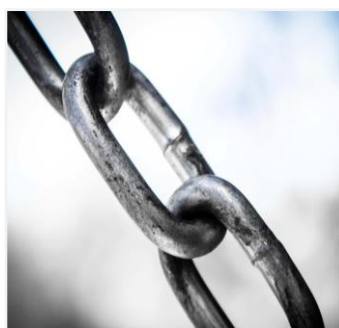
By increasing awareness across south west London, we can all do our part in keeping safe vulnerable adults, wherever they live and whenever they access services.

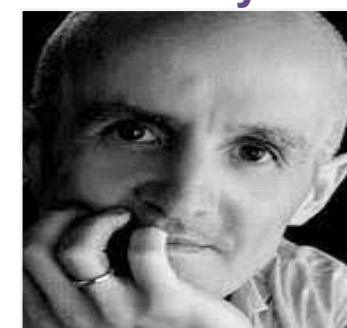

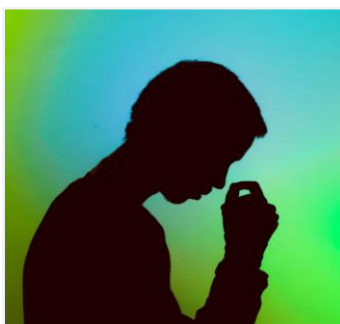
